### How to register – Two Registrations Required!

Every player will need complete two registrations. Both registrations must be completed before your student will be permitted to play. The online registration with Disc NW is free, it includes waivers and contact info and takes just a few minutes to fill out.

- 1) Register for Hazel Wolf Ultimate by completing the registration form and returning it to coaches at the Feb 9<sup>th</sup> Maple Leaf Park practice or to the front office **by Feb 8<sup>th</sup>**. If we have space, we will accept registrations after Feb 9<sup>th</sup> on a first-come, first-served basis until Feb 25<sup>th</sup>.
