

## Hazel Wolf Middle School Ultimate – SPRING 2019 INFO SHEET

Spring Ultimate is a co-ed, recreational league (ie. not a school sponsored sport) for Hazel Wolf students. We are aiming for two teams. The number of teams and number of players per roster will depend upon how many players register and how many coaches are available.

The 2019 spring ultimate season runs from February 30 through May 18.

### How to register? This must be done by 2/25!

Every player will need to register by completing the Hazel Wolf registration form and by registering with DiscNW. Both registrations must be completed before your student will be permitted to play.

Do this first and as soon as you can **but no later than February 25** as we need to determine how many players we will have to meet DiscNW team registration deadlines.

2) Register your student with DiscNW by completing the registration at the following link:

During this registration please select the team, "Hazel Wolf A" and we will adjust after tryouts. You may need to create a new account and player if you do not have an account with DiscNW's new system.

### Tryouts

Tryouts for spring ultimate will be held on Wednesday, February 27 from 5:00 to 6:30pm and Saturday, March 2, from 10am-12pm. Tryouts will take place at Maple Leaf Park on the upper grass fields.

The purpose of assessments is to help coaches determine who is interested in playing spring ultimate and place them on an appropriate team based on three determining factors:

1. Spirit of the game: See info here at <http://www.discnw.org/spirit-of-the-game>
2. Commitment to Spring Ultimate: attendance to games, practices, and Spring Reign
3. Experience and skills: prior years experience and tryout observations

Since space is limited, unfortunately not everyone interested may be able to play. We have room for approximately 15-17 players on each team. We will try to email team assignments by Monday on March 4th.

### Participation Fee

Cost to play will be \$90 per participant. The fee covers the DiscNW league fee, Spring Reign fee, end of season party, and scholarships. Payment must be received by March 6 for your student to participate. No fee is due if your student is not placed on a team after tryouts. Scholarships may be available. ### Spring Reign

This is a youth tournament in Burlington, WA on April 27 and 28. There are a limited number of spots for this tournament however we plan to register two teams.
